NAPSF Member Spotlight: Elkhorn Public Schools Foundation

Summer greetings from the Elkhorn Public Schools Foundation!

It's hard to believe summer is quickly coming to an end. I hope you are all refreshed and ready for the new school year! September will mark our one-year anniversary in the new Foundation offices and Alumni Center. For years, the Foundation leased a small office space that we outgrew as the Elkhorn Public Schools District grew. Employees were doubled up sharing office space. Copy paper and supplies lined the hallways on a regular basis. Not only does our building have a



large workroom, office space to accommodate growth and plenty of storage, it also has a large lower level where we can host Foundation, school and community events. During the past year, the Alumni Center space has been used for all kinds of events, including a pre-school graduation, class reunions, teacher and corporate trainings, sports booster club banquets, high school graduation parties, as well as the Foundation's Hall of Fame awards reception and our Bids 4 Kids Ladies Shopping fundraiser!

The primary revenue generator for most of the Foundation's programs is our Elkhorn Kids Campus Before & After School Care Program. This upcoming school year, we have over 1100 students registered in our Kids Campus program! With help from our Site Directors and Elkhorn area high school students working as Child Care Assistants, we provide care at all 11 elementary schools, soon to be 12 schools in 2020-2021. With the revenue generated from Elkhorn Kids Campus, this past year we funded Math & Reading Intervention tutoring for over 500 elementary students, Classroom Grants for all school buildings, and ACHIEVE Scholarships for 172 high school graduates!

With the addition of a 3rd high school in 2020-2021, the District is renovating the shared football stadium located at Elkhorn High School. The previously passed bond is funding additional bleacher seating, concessions, and bathrooms, but it did not provide funding for a new state of the art scoreboard. The Foundation has partnered with the District and is providing funding for the new scoreboard through ScoreVision. Currently, we are in the process of selling advertising sponsorships to recuperate our costs for this project. We are proud to announce that Pinnacle Bank has signed to be our Title Sponsor. Their name will be prominently displayed on the scoreboard, as well as advertised during all sporting events held at the stadium during the next 5 years. There are many other sponsorship opportunities available, and we are so excited by the response that we have been receiving from the local businesses in our community!

Some other highlights from this year: Last spring, the Elkhorn Public Schools Foundation was honored as the West O Chamber's "Nonprofit of the Year"! Last month, we completed a Strategic Planning session with our Foundation Board members, Foundation Staff and District administrators. We focused on setting new goals and identifying areas that we can more closely align with the District and its goals. Currently, we are gearing up for our TEAM Staff Campaign and for our 5K fundraiser with Elkhorn Soccer Club to raise funds for Special Education Grants!

As the new school year is upon us, I wish you all a successful new year. Thank you for all the hard work you provide daily to support the school districts across Nebraska!
