
NSFA Conference Scholarship Winners


The Phase 1 Workshop: Foundational Training in Historical and Institutional Racism by the Racial Equity Institute Workshop. Even those who are concerned about racial disparities in all American systems and institutions are challenged in their understanding of how racism remains alive and well, advantaging some, while harming others. REI's two-day Phase 1 training is designed to develop the capacity of participants to understand racism in its institutional and structural forms. Moving the focus from individual bigotry and bias, the Racial Equity Institute's Phase 1 workshop presents a historical, cultural, structural, and institutional analysis of racism.
