Taste of Victory Tailgate

Each Fall in Wayne, Wayne Area Economic Development and the Wayne Community Schools Foundation host a "Taste of Victory" Tailgate Party before a Wayne Blue Devils Football game. The event is coordinated by the Wayne Area Economic Development, which serves in part as the Chamber Office in Wayne. The purpose of the tailgate



party is to raise funds which are then donated to the Wayne Community Schools Foundation. The money raised, in turn, helps provide funds for scholarships and programs coordinated through the school foundation.

At the tailgate party, community businesses provide specialty tailgate items for patrons to sample. Some of these tasty treats include chili, pulled pork, desert items, taco's, jambalaya, hamburgers, and brats. The community businesses prepare and serve sample size items to all who attend. There is no direct charge for our patrons, however patrons are asked to put their dollars in a jar at their favorite stand. The funds are then tabulated, and the business with the highest donation amount in their jar is announced as the winner!



Not only is this a great fundraiser, it is a fun event that brings our businesses and patrons together to support a great cause. Since the event began five years ago over \$7,500 has been raised to support the efforts of the Wayne Community Schools Foundation. The real winners however are the students at Wayne, and the community. This event is a very popular school and community event that brings together hundreds of people. The event has become so popular that even the opposing school fans that attend the game ask to make sure the Taste of Victory Tailgate is scheduled the next time

they come to town to play the Blue Devils!

The Taste of Victory Tailgate, under the Friday night lights, is an outstanding community and school event that brings people together to support the students at Wayne Community Schools. 
